<u>Parent Teacher Interviews</u>: Thanks to all the families who attended the parent teacher interviews this week. I hope you found it valuable, and feel that it set up a positive partnership for the year ahead. Don't forget if you need to see your child's teacher at any point outside of parent teacher interviews, please email them to arrange a mutually suitable time.

<u>School Council Forms</u>: Please give serious consideration to joining School Council. Our school cannot operate without effective parent representation. Please return nomination forms by NEXT TUESDAY 19TH. We are looking to fill 3-4 positions this year and would love for you to join our School Council and have input into school decisions that will impact on all students in the school.

<u>Talking Homework</u>: Every second Wednesday, all students receive 'Talking Homework.' This is to be completed that evening or the following morning in readiness for the 'Big Write' which occurs every second Thursday. 


