## PRINCIPAL'S MESSAGE

**Pupil Free Day:** Thursday the 12th September will be a Pupil Free Day. On this day teachers will work together to collaboratively document our yearly writing program. We will also spend time looking at student's current achievement in writing and set new learning goals for each student.

**Mulan Performance:** On Thursday next week all 3-6 students will be attending a performance of Mulan at Victory College. They will travel by bus and there is no costs to the students for this event. Permission is covered by the Local Excursion permission note.

**Italian Film Festival:** On Wednesday, the 5/6 students showcased the movies they made using a 'green screen' app. They utilised Media Arts skills, while practising their fluency speaking Italian. Paddy and Nick were chosen as the winners and received 2 tickets each to the Regent Cinema in Albury. Their movie 'Pisa or Pizza?' showed a clear storyline and reflected the boys sense of humour.

**Cooking Update:** This week the 5/6 students made gluten and dairy free kiss biscuits and the 3/4 students made chicken and mushroom tortellini with a creamy tomato sauce. The students are gaining confidence using the kitchen equipment and are realising that cleaning is also part of the cooking and eating process, not just preparing and eating. It would be great if you are able to include your child in the cooking process at home so they continue to gain confidence when cooking at school.

**Swimming:** This year swimming lessons will being conducted for **all students from F-6**. This will occur during Week 8 (2nd-6th September). F-3 families have already paid for their child's lessons in their school fees, and they will receive a \$20 credit onto their child's account. All students in Year 4-6 will be charged \$38 for 5 lessons including the 5 bus trips. The permission notes will go out Monday, and payment is due by Friday August 30th.

**Skiing:** Todays planned ski trip had to be cancelled at the last minute due to a deteriorating weather forecast and a gale force wind warning. We do hope to be able to go next Friday. Thanks everyone for your understanding.

**Working Bee:** On Saturday 7th September, the school will be holding a working bee from 9:30-1:00. We are hoping to have beautiful weather to be able to upgrade the sandpit by adding new sand and edging, as well as paint the sports shed, tepees, and playground poles. We will be having a BBQ lunch at the end of the day and we would love as many people to attend as possible as it will be a big job.

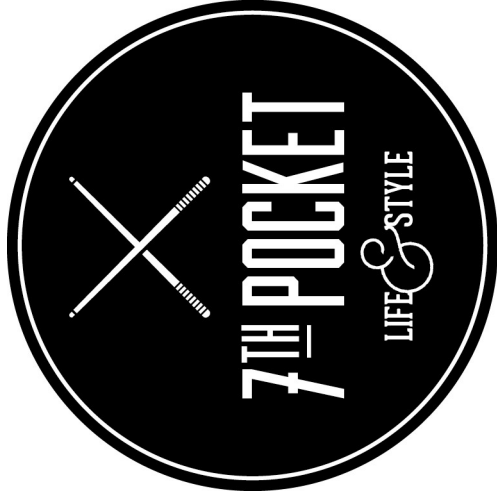

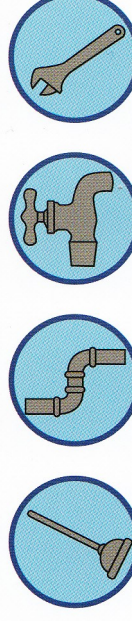
